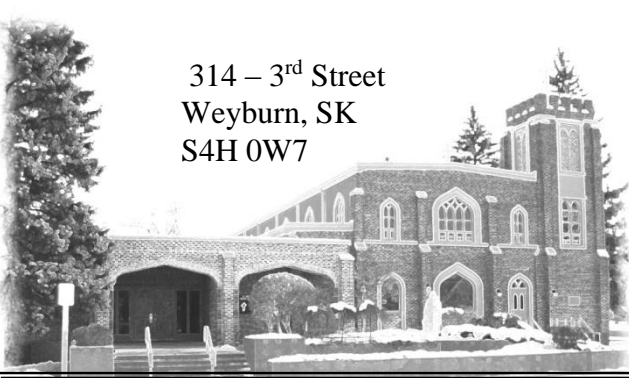

### Good News.....

My brother, sister, and I learned to sail when we were young. Of all the lessons we had, the one I remember nearly verbatim was “Signs of an Approaching Storm.” I can reel off the list as though it were yesterday: dark, low, fast-moving clouds, a sudden shift in wind direction and velocity, a sudden change in temperature.

To this day, when I experience any of these things, I close windows and make sure everything is inside. I think the apostles who were seasoned fishermen must have had similar training, and I have often wondered why they just didn't make for shore when they noticed the signs. But then I remember that some storms move in very quickly and, if you are in the middle of the sea, you can't make it to shore easily. The apostles may have decided to ride it out and then realized they could not.

It must have struck the apostles as odd that Jesus was peacefully asleep while they battled rising water and fierce wind. They were afraid of losing their lives. When they woke Jesus up, Scripture says that he “rebuked” the wind and the sea. The same word is used when Jesus casts out demons. The result is peace—at least on the sea or in the person who is possessed.

But for the disciples and for us, the act inspires awe and not a little anxiety: “Who then is this?” The answer unfolds for us throughout the Gospels. Jesus is Lord over the wind and sea, over all creation, and over us as well. In storm or calm, he brings his peace and shows us God's glory.

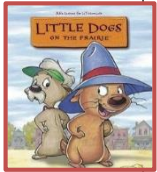

#### FROM PASTOR'S DESK:

Although we are heading into the summer season and school will soon be finished for this academic year, and many parishes adopt a lighter schedule of Masses on Sundays and the Parish Offices are opened at reduced hours (to allow staff time for holidays), the parish does not shut down for the summer, as the regular Sunday Masses and weekday Masses are offered and I am available all through the summer. You might try my cell number (306-861-3011) **after you have tried the Parish Office (306-842-2129)**, and please leave a message. It may be a simple matter than I am on another call, out of office range in the church putting something away, and your message can be returned shortly. In the event of any emergency, such as a request for the Sacrament of the Sick, always use the cell number and leave a message. It may not be convenient to answer your call on that moment, but I can always retrieve your voicemail or text message. I cannot emphasize enough the importance of leaving a message, because this is the only reasonable way of getting back to you in a timely fashion. If your call is not an urgent nature, and the matter can wait until later, there is no need to duplicate leaving a message both at the Office and on my cell phone. Our current phone system records all incoming calls on the Receptionist's phone, but retrieving them is not a very convenient way of seeing all the missed calls, as names are abbreviated or blocked. Simply returning every missed call is not how we operate presently when we are fully staff, so why would do so when we are working with limited staff; if you wish your call to be returned, kindly leave a message and someone will get back to you shortly. Enough about this for now, as I wanted to remind everyone, whether you take the whole summer off, or part of it, all the operating costs remain in place for the parish and bills need to be paid, just as they did for your own household. This might be a good time to remember that your parish depends upon your financial contributions whether you are here or not. There have been a few leaks in some sections of the roof at McKenna Auditorium, and this summer might be the time that we undertake an entire new roof at McKenna, rather than just tackling the problem areas, as it would seem that it has been many years since anything extensive over the roof has been done in the past. With fewer events scheduled at McKenna, it might be a good time to address some of these issues. We remain very grateful for all those who continue their support and involvement in the parish over the summer months, as we are relying much of that continued involvement and participation. If you recognize a need, please do not be afraid to volunteer and step up to fill the need. May God bless you all and your families. Happy Father's Day!
