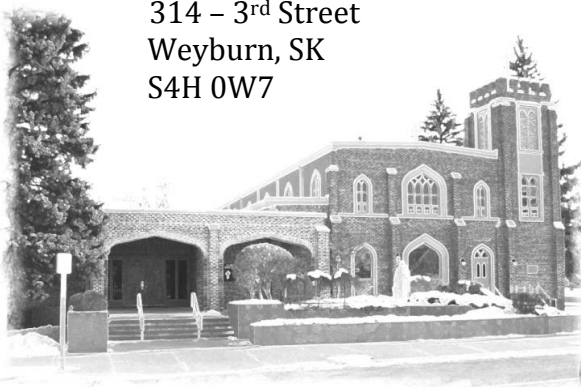

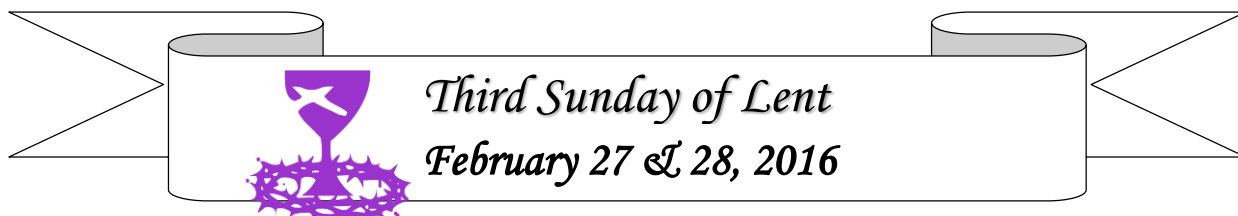
Good News!

Now that I am older, I can look back on my life and clearly remember times when I took great pride in my accomplishments, the breadth of my knowledge, and my insight into human dynamics. The problem was that my pride bordered on, and occasionally slipped into, a sense of superiority and hubris. At such times I was not fun to be around. The advantage of maturity is that we become more aware of our shortcomings and, hopefully, develop a humility that appreciates the gifts that everyone brings to the table, recognizes that we always have more to learn, and grows grateful, rather than prideful, at the gifts we have been given.

In today's Gospel, Jesus challenges the sense of pride that the Israelites feel from God's choosing them and the sense that they are, therefore, better than the people of the surrounding nations. He also questions their habit of judging those on whom misfortune fell as more sinful than they were. In a way, he was asking them to grow up and find the humility that comes from age, holding them to the same standard with which they held others. He challenged them to spend less time judging others and more time recognizing their sins and need for repentance.

That's a hard lesson for us all, but a necessary one. If we are to accompany one another on this journey through Lent and life, we need to know we are all the same in God's eyes and all in need of God's grace to make it through.

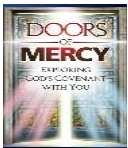


Soup before Stations – Soup & buns will be served in our church basement before the Stations Friday evenings at 6:15 – all are welcome!

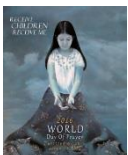

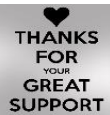

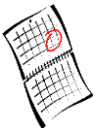

FROM PASTOR'S DESK:

In the promotional materials sent for our upcoming Lenten Parish Mission by Deacon Bob & Joan Williston, *“The Eucharist: Unfolding the Mercy of God”* our themes for the four evenings are “Receive, Give Thanks, Break and Share” from Sunday to Wednesday evenings inclusive, March 6 – 9, all starting at 7 PM. The first theme on Sunday evening is “Receive: The Gift of God’s Grace”, wherein receptivity is crucial posture for Christians in the relationship with God and in their relationship to all life. Receiving means a certain kind of openness to God which Christ Himself lived through the Cross to the Resurrection. We enter into this openness to God via the Eucharist. The second theme on Monday evening is “Give Thanks: In an Attitude of Gratitude”, wherein gratitude is at the core of the Eucharistic celebration. We are meant to be a people of thanksgiving, both in our prayer life and in our relationships with one another. God’s grace is active all around us, if we but open our eyes and hearts to see. The third theme on Tuesday evening is “Break: The Bread and Word of Life”, wherein we focus on the words of Jesus, “This is My Body, broken for you...” Christ’s brokenness is the ultimate act of God’s love for us. Our own brokenness often makes it difficult to love or to be loved. As the prophet Isaiah promised, “By His wounds, we are healed.” This presentation will be followed by the opportunity for sacramental reconciliation with priests of the Weyburn Deanery in attendance. The final theme on Wednesday evening is “Share: With Others in Love”, wherein the Eucharist transforms us to love as Christ loved, and to share with others what He has entrusted to us. Jesus has made us His Body, the Body of Christ, to serve our brothers and sisters here on this earth. All we have received is not only for ourselves! In preparation for the success of the mission, we are exhorted to Pray, Visit, and Invite. We might pray this Mission Prayer: *“Lord Jesus Christ, You have prayed that we will be one as You and Your Father are one. Send your Holy Spirit upon us as we pray for the success of our Parish Mission, and upon Deacon Bob and Joan Williston who will be presenting it to us. May it be a source of grace and draw us, your people, into a closer union with You and with each other. God our Father, we ask this through Christ our Lord, in the love and unity of your Holy Spirit. Amen.”* I strongly urge you to take this opportunity to attend all four evenings, and if not, at least as many evenings as you are able. You will be greatly enriched and depend your appreciation of the abundant Mercy of God poured out through His Word and Sacraments.
