Attention: The number for attendance at Eucharistic services has increased to 150. You no longer need to call the office to register.

We are following the guidelines of the Saskatchewan Government and the Archdiocese. Therefore social distancing is a must! We are asking those who attend to follow the guidelines so we can have a safe service. There will be no cup only the bread and it will be set out for individuals to take their own, not touching any of the others. After each mass the pews that were used are sanitized according to the guidelines.

We would like to remind you the dispensation from attending the Sunday Eucharist is still in effect by our Archbishop.

On the weekend we are celebrating mass on Saturdays at 5 pm and Sundays 9 am and 11 am. Weekdays are Tuesdays at 7pm, Wednesday & Thursday at 9am and Friday at 12:10pm.

At this time we are not allowed to have singing and masks are a choice but must be worn for any singing!

Children are welcome but must be contained to the 6ft limit. Families can sit together.

Readers are asked to read from the extra mic, not the altar. You are asked to read both of the Readings, the Psalm and the Gospel Acclamation. Copies of the readings will be in the sacristy for each of you.

We will only require 2 Hospitality people per mass. One person should be located at the door and one directing to the pews.

At this time we will not need any other ministries.

Please be seated in the area designated for the particular Mass. Cleaning will be done so that each section will be sanitized before use. In order to ensure proper physical distancing please be sure to sit 2 metres away from others who don't live in your household. Of course individual couples and families can sit together. The problem is that we are allowed up to 5 groups of 30 people with 5 metres distance between each group! This takes some planning! Thank you for your patience and understanding during this difficult time!!!

TUESDAY MASS: Section by the choir

WEDNESDAY MASS: Centre Section

THURSDAY MASS: Right Section

FRIDAY MASS: Section by the choir

SATURDAY 5:00 MASS: Centre Section & Far Choir Section if needed

SUNDAY 9:00 MASS: Section by the choir including the Far Choir Section and Right Section (not including the far right).

SUNDAY 11:00 MASS: Centre Section, Far Right Section, Chapel and Balcony (choir loft) if needed

We always need to be aware of which sections are used, so they can be cleaned before next use. We are also trying to avoid the necessity of cleaning the whole church after every Mass. If larger numbers are in attendance, we would be very pleased and willing to sit people in other sections, but within the distance requirements. Thank you!
